## THE DRAMBUIE AYRSHIRE GOLF CLASSIC

2nd - 6th May 2004

Turnberry Ailsa | Turnberry Kintyre | Kilmarnock Barassie | Belleisle

When this event was launched into the unknown in 2000 little was it realised that it was going to become the forerunner of a series of Scottish Golf Classics! The event teed off in July of the Millennium at the Ailsa Course at Turnberry and it is fitting that the event returns to celebrate its fifth year.



2004 also sees a move from July to the more attractive week at the beginning of May. The weather around the west coast of Scotland in late spring is quite often spectacular with the courses all reaching their very best condition.

The four courses for 2004 are of the expected high standard, The Ailsa is best known as the venue for that famous Open Championship Duel in the Sun between Nicklaus and Watson, which was re-enacted in 2003 at the British Seniors Open. They've even renamed the eighteenth to mark it!

The Ailsa is supported by its new neighbour The Kintyre which will be a Final Qualifying course for the 2004 Open Championship, so expect it to be in mint condition. The other 36 holes are made up by Barassie Links in Troon itself and Belleisle in Ayr which itself has hosted many top events.

And the social angle? The drinks reception on the Sunday evening will be hosted in a castle, the now annual Quiz Night and Dinner will be held on the Tuesday in Troon with the prizegiving dinner on the Thursday night signing the card off.

We've also added some unbelievably good value hotel inclusive deals, the five star Lodges at Turnberry Hotel from just over £500 for five nights accommodation and golf, complimentary use of the Academy and practice course. Three star hotels are available from as little as £395 B & B inclusive of golf. A limited number of golf only packages are available at £270 per golfer.

Wednesday sees play over Belleisle making its third appearance in the Ayrshire Classic.

#### Thursday 6th May

The final eighteen holes of this year's event again sees us return to the wonderful set-up at Turnberry for play over the Ailsa and Kintrye Courses. Tee times for the final day will be drawn on the close of play and can be viewed either on line or at your hotel. The week's golf is then rounded off sweetly with the prizegiving dinner. The dinner is this again being held at The Marine Hotel in Troon over looking Royal Troon.
